

Dear Parents,

Now that all the competitors have signed up for CSA Festival and Competition, we now know what categories will be holding run-offs so that we can narrow down each category to two competitors. Categories that only have one or two competitors do not require a run-off.

For the run-offs, students need to have 2 sets of their piece for the judges, as well as 2 prepared judges' sheets.

After Christmas Break, Division Coordinators will distribute specific schedules and details for the run-offs as necessary.

Listed below are all of the categories that require run-offs. Unless otherwise specified, run-offs will take place during the official run-offs week, January 11-14.

Testing—All testing will be held at a later date.

Chess—Coach Brown is handling brackets for chess.

Elementary Art—Artist Statements are due by Thursday, December 17. The absolute latest that the art project may be turned in is Friday, January 8.

Elementary Spelling Bee—Spelling Bee will occur during Grandparent's Day, Friday, January 22.

Elementary Duet Acting—Selections must be memorized. Run-offs will be Thursday, January 14.

Elementary Bible Memory—The first page of selected Bible Memory must be memorized for run-offs.

Elementary Vocal Solo (Female and Male) and Small Ensemble—Memorization is optional, though it will factor into the judging.

Elementary Instrumental Solo (brass, woodwind, percussion, strings) —Memorization is optional, though it will factor into the judging.

Elementary Instrumental Ensemble (small and large)

Elementary Classical Piano Solo—Solo must be memorized.

Junior High Art—The absolute latest that the art project and Artist Statement may be turned in is Tuesday, January 5.

Junior High Vocal Solo (Female and Male) and Small Ensemble—Memorization is optional, though it will factor into the judging.

Junior High Instrumental Solo (brass, woodwind, percussion, strings) —Memorization is optional, though it will factor into the judging.

Junior High Instrumental Ensemble (small and large)

Junior High Classical Piano Solo—Solo must be memorized.

High School Art—The absolute latest that the art project and Artist Statement may be turned in is Tuesday, January 5.

High School Duet Acting—Must be memorized for run-offs Wednesday, January 20 (extended deadline)

High School Vocal Solo (Female and Male) and Small Ensemble—

Memorization is optional, though it will factor into the judging.

High School Instrumental Solo (brass, woodwind, percussion, strings)—

Memorization is optional, though it will factor into the judging.
