Schedule and Cost

Cost is \$100 (\$120 if registered after April 12; \$150 if registered on June 15); \$30 is due with registration, the balance is to be paid on arrival.

Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. on Monday, June 15. Camp begins at 8:30 a.m. each morning and ends at 4:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday. Camp finishes on Friday after the 7:00 p.m. concert.

Housing and Meals

Lunch and a snack will be provided each day and a pizza party on Friday night. The Warrior Window will be open for additional drink and snack purchases.

Housing will be arranged for those who live out of town. The cost is \$25.

What to Bring
