

Frequently Asked Questions

How much does tuition cost?

Tuition is around \$4,000 per year and includes most fees. Tuition varies depending on the grade and number of students in the family enrolled. For detailed tuition information, visit www.tcawarriors.org.

Is before and after school care offered?

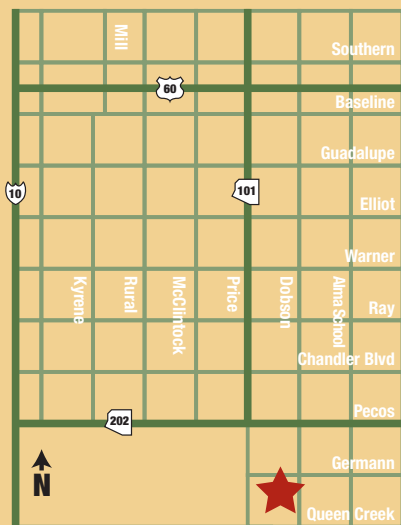
