HIGH SCHOOL SCHEDULING DAY

High school students will be signing up for their classes on "Scheduling Day." The days and times are as follows:

High school students may also purchase P.E. uniforms, open a lunch account, pay tuition, and sign up for music lessons on "Scheduling Day." There will not be a special scheduling day for the junior high students, although they will need to let us know whether or not they wish to participate in our band program.

SCHOOL WIDE ORIENTATION AND OPEN HOUSE

We are so excited to begin the 2009-2010 school year at our brand new facility in Chandler. Along with a new facility come all new procedures for how the daily operations of the school will run. Please join us Friday, August 21 for our annual Orientation/Open House. We will begin the evening at 5:00 p.m. and conclude at 8:30 p.m. The orientation portion of the evening will begin at 6:30 p.m. in the new auditorium. **We highly encourage everyone to attend the orientation portion of the evening where we will be covering important information about day to day procedures. You will not want to miss it!** Before and after the orientation, families will be welcome to visit classrooms, tour the facility, purchase P.E. uniforms, and visit our business office to set up a lunch account and/or pay tuition. 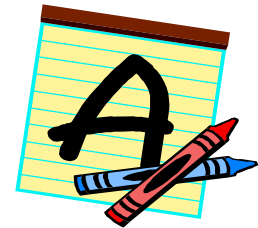
