who wanted to upgrade his skills. It was great to see the fruit of many years of effort. Several unsaved family and friends

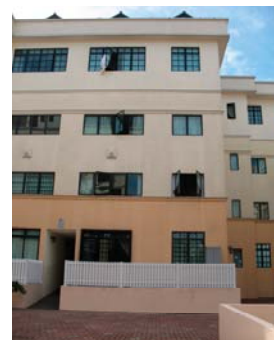
